A Workshop for Prospectors and Junior Mining Companies Working in the Treaty #3 Area

Grand Council Treaty #3 is the traditional government of the Anishinaabe Nation. Treaty #3 extends from the Manitoba border east to Shebandowan Lake and from the U.S. border to north of Red Lake, an area of approximately 55,000 square miles.

Changes to the Constitution in 1982 have prompted the Grand Council to recently state that "Any development in Treaty #3 Territory...requires the consent, agreement and participation of the Anishinaabe Nation..."

This workshop is for prospectors who are working or planning to work in this area and need to understand the implications of this statement. For any mining claim that is recorded in Ontario, MNDM will be sending the claimholder a list of First Nations they are recommended to contact prior to starting work on their claims.
